University: Qualified in Vet Med [MVB, MRCVS] from University College Dublin in 1964.

After 5 months in mixed practice in Meath and Mayo, Phil was awarded a Research Scholarship to An Foras Taluntais (AFT, the Irish Agricultural Institute, now part of Teagasc - the Agriculture and Food Authority of Ireland). He joined the research staff of the Field investigations Department of AFT in 1965 and was promoted rapidly to Principal Research Officer.

His research field in AFT was in mineral imbalances and metabolic disorders in ruminants. He was a National Adviser on these areas to the Teagasc Advisory service and the Irish ruminant feed industry. After 41 years of research and advisory work, he retired from Teagasc in December 2005.

Phil's study of acupuncture & TCM began as a hobby in 1973. He was one of the first Associate Members of IVAS (International Veterinary Acupuncture Society, founded in 1974) and has been on the IVAS Teaching Panel since 1982. He has lectured at acupuncture training courses (mainly for vets, but also for medical doctors) and congresses in Austria, Australia, Belgium, Brazil, Canada, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Iceland, Ireland, Korea, Japan, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan, UK and USA.
