

A TCVM Approach to Managing Rescue Animals

Every day veterinary practitioners are faced with caretakers who have adopted or rescued animals of all ages and breeds who have been the victims of neglect and abuse. Many animals have residual developmental, musculoskeletal and dermal trauma and scarring. Most of these animals have some residual Shen disturbances that can lead to significant behavioral and emotional abnormalities that could jeopardize their abilities to finding or staying in a loving home. This presentation will discuss how practitioners can utilize TCVM approaches to recognize and rebalance nutrition and help heal deep and old wounds, both physical and emotional.
