Sue was a science scholar at Oxford University before qualifying as a vet at Bristol in 1983. After many years in equine practice she studied acupuncture with the International Veterinary Acupuncture Society in her quest to relieve horses of pain that did not respond to rest and non-steroidal anti-inflammatory medication, becoming a Certified Veterinary Acupuncturist in 2001. In 2002 she established her equine acupuncture practice and added chiropractic in 2011; she is now an instructor for the International Academy of Veterinary Chiropractic. Sue's work on treating trigeminal-mediated headshaking with electroacupuncture was published in Equine Veterinary Education in 2019 and she is the author of The Veterinary Care of the Horse. Sue's enthusiasm for treating horses with acupuncture and embracing new ideas remains undiminished after 20 years of practising acupuncture.
