

Manoj K. Shah, PhD, DVM, Associate Professor

Dr. Manoj K. Shah is an Associate Professor (Veterinary Surgery) and Research Scientist at the Department of Surgery and Pharmacology, Agriculture and Forestry University, Nepal. He has an academic and scientific carrier of two decades. During his scientific carrier, he spent a period of time undertaking pain and electroacupuncture related research in China (Huazhong Agricultural University).

He established the Crohn's ileitis model to probe the pathogenesis of gut inflammation and visceral hypersensitivity, as well as for establishing the therapeutic protocol for Crohn's ileitis. His research focuses on the molecular investigation of visceral pain mechanism with a specific interest in electroacupuncture intervention in spinal PAR-2 and CGRP release during visceral hypersensitivity. He has published several research articles and review papers in reputed scientific journals. He also contributed as editor and reviewer for relevant journals of his interest areas.
