CYNTHIA LANKENAU, DVM, RH (AHG), MS-TCVM

Cynthia Lankenau, DVM graduated from Cornell's Veterinary College in 1981 and joined a 99% dairy practice in upstate NY with a total love of working with small dairy farms. In the attempt to expand her practice knowledge, she joined

the Peace Corps and worked in Malawi, Africa in 1984-1985, returning to the US to join a mixed animal practice in western NY. With the decline of family farms in NY, and seeing an incredible increase in chronic diseases, Dr. Lankenau started down the path of alternative medicine; starting with acupuncture training in 1991 (IVAS), started herbal training in western herbs in 1993, Chinese herbs in 1995; chiropractic (AVCA) and homeopathic (AVH) training in 1995. She has completed Chi's MS (TCVM); CIVT's Western Graduate Herbal program, and Chinese herbal degree; is a registered herbalist (RH) through the American Herbal Guild, and finished David Winston's professional and Graduate herbal training. Further Chinese Herbal training is ongoing with Dr. Evan Rabinowitz and by attending as many Jeffrey Yuen seminars as possible. She is a past president of the VBMA, Secretary/Treasurer of the ACVBM, founder of the NY CAVMA, and on the board of WATCVM. Since 1993, she has practiced in a solo 100% alternative modality mixed animal practice.

In 1988, Dr. Ronald Riegel completed the coursework and examination for inclusion into the Human Academy of Neuromuscular Physiology. This was the first Academy to providing information on the clinical use of infrared thermography in the human field. He was the only veterinarian in the class of 70. He purchased his first infrared thermograph (AGEMA) in 1987 and first therapy laser in 1979.

Dr. Riegel was the sole owner of a multi-doctor practice until 2009, when he co-founded the American Institute of Medical Laser Applications. This RACE-approved educational platform provides online, onsite, and speakers for healthcare professionals and veterinarians in photo biomodulation therapy, infrared thermography, and regenerative medicine techniques.



BARRIE SANDS,

Dr. Barrie Sands received her DVM degree from Ross University in 1991. She completed a small animal medicine and surgery internship at the Animal Medical Center in NYC. After working in private practice she moved to San Diego to take on her current position as senior staff clinician in the Emergency Critical Care department at a VCA Specialty and Referral Hospital.

In 2003 she became certified in acupuncture (IVAS) and started her holistic/functional medicine practice instituting modalities

such as acupuncture, nutrition, cold LASER, homeopathy, homotoxicology, medicinal botany, physical and massage therapy, and various types of energy medicine.
