The XXV S.I.A.V. International Congress focuses on the first period of life of the animal, from intrauterine life to the moment of growth.

Through the talks of speakers, we will have the opportunity to learn how Traditional Chinese Medicine interprets the first moments of life formation and which energies are most involved in the conception and growth of the new individual.

Wide space will be given to prevention and treatment modalities according to the disciplines of MVTC and the new related techniques, so as to provide the veterinarian with a wide range of therapeutic and preventive possibilities for pregnancy and growth disorders, in a perspective of integration of medicines that aims to ensure the well-being of the fetus and the mother and the prevention of the development of diseases in the growth phase.

Prior to that, he was an assistant clinical professor at LSU Veterinary School (2013-2020), where he pioneered the Integrative Medicine Service, emphasizing Traditional Chinese Veterinary Medicine and rehabilitation. Dr. Koh is board-certified in Veterinary Sports Medicine and Rehabilitation (DACVSMR), and was recently named a Charter Fellow of the American College of Veterinary Botanical Medicine (FACVBM). His certifications span acupuncture, Chinese herbal therapy, food therapy, rehabilitation, and medical manipulation. Dr. Koh's extensive authorship includes numerous book chapters and peer-reviewed articles on TCVM, acupuncture, integrative medicine, and rehabilitation. He is both an editor and author of "Veterinary Acupuncture: The New Concepts" [in Chinese]. Dr. Koh is a national and international speaker on acupuncture, TCVM, integrative medicine, and rehabilitation, with several Excellent Speaker Awards from Chi University and WATCVM to his credit. In 2021, he received the prestigious Ma Shi Huang Award from Chi University, acknowledging his outstanding contributions in TCVM. 
